About the Julian Teaching School Hub

the Julian Teaching School Hub (TSH) serves schools in Broadland, King's Lynn and West Norfolk, North Norfolk, and Norwich. It is an Appropriate Body and quality assures the statutory induction of ECTs in schools which register with it.

The role of Appropriate Bodies

Appropriate Bodies independently quality assure statutory induction, ensuring that schools provide adequate support for their ECTs; that their assessment is fair and consistent across all institutions; and that they are receiving a programme of support and training based on the ECF. If an ECT is not registered with an Appropriate Body, they are unable to begin their induction period. Retrospective or backdated registrations are not possible.

Early career teacher (ECT) induction overview

There are three approaches to enable the delivery of an ECF-based induction. Schools can choose to:

- Use a DfE-funded training provider
- Use DfE-accredited materials to deliver their own training
- Design and deliver their own ECF-based training.

It is up to school leaders to choose the approach that best suits the needs of their early career teachers and mentors.

In addition to serving as an Appropriate Body, the Julian Teaching School Hub is a delivery partner of Ambition Institute, delivering the funded training programme. This is a paperless system for recording data securely, submitting assessments, accessing resources, raising alerts and managing ECTs during induction.

Induction can only commence once we have checked and approved your registrations.

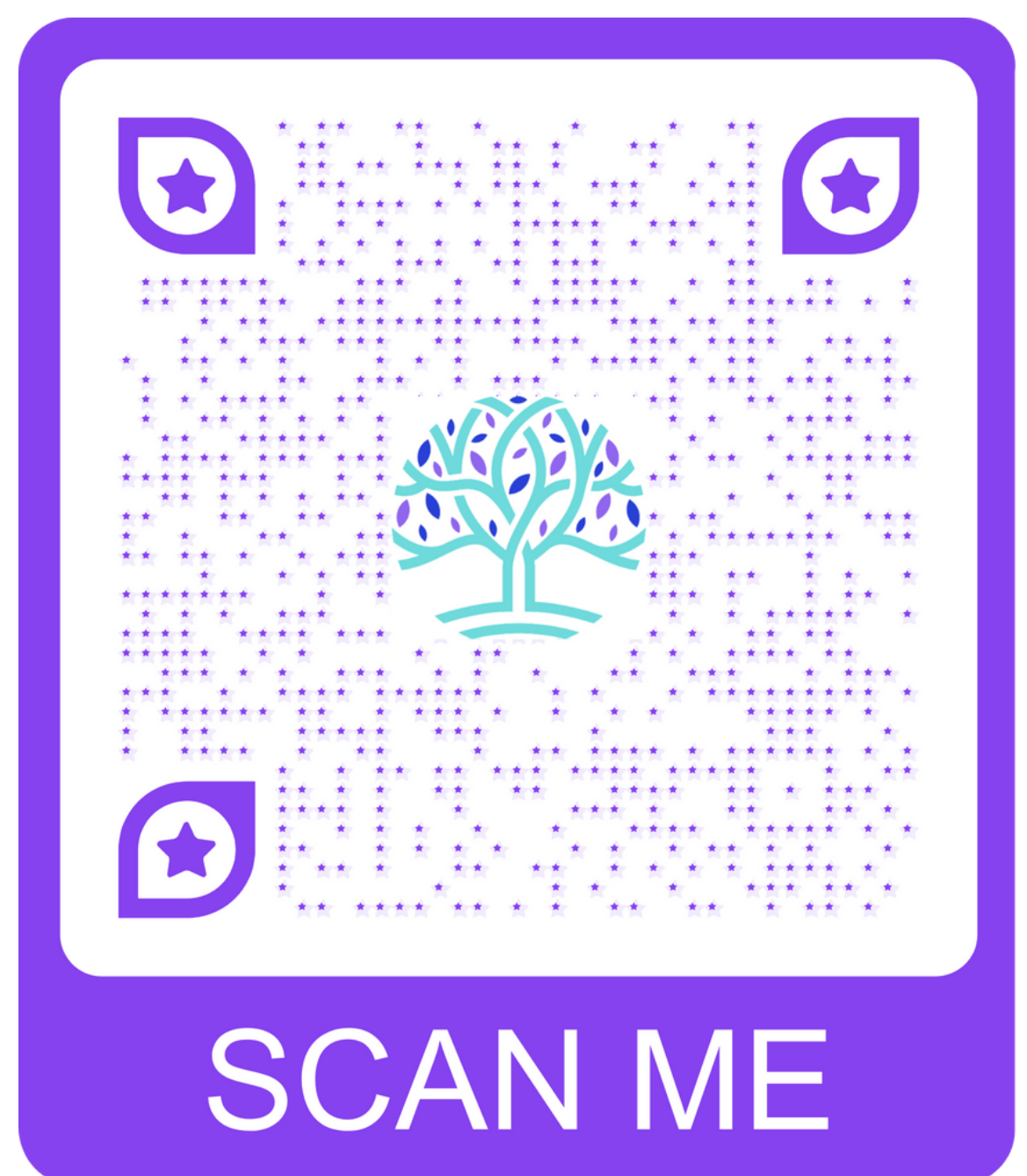
