

Norfolk Teacher Training Centre: Mentor training from September 2024

From September all ITT providers will be required to provide and log mentor training under new requirements.

Each mentor will need to complete 20 hours of training- this is the case for every ITT provider.

All training is online. Core sessions will be recorded; NASBTT modules to be completed at your convenience.

Once your 20 hours have been completed, you will only need to complete our Core training offering of six hours annually.

Developing: Once only training for anyone new to mentoring.

Experienced: Once only training for anyone experienced in mentoring.
