



EARLY HEADSHIP COACHING OFFER

The Early Headship Coaching Offer (EHCO) provides structured, unassessed support based on the best available evidence about what makes an effective headteacher.

Delivered by the Julian Teaching School Hub in partnership with the Teacher Development Trust (TDT) and Educate Norfolk.

Am I eligible?

You are eligible if you meet all of these criteria:

- You are in your first 5 years of headship
- You are employed in England in a state-funded school or state-funded 16-19 organisation when you begin the programme
- You have either completed an NPQH or are taking one
- You have not withdrawn from the Additional Support Offer or EHCO previously.

Is there funding?

Yes! Full DfE funding, with no cost to the participant or their setting, is available to those eligible according to the criteria above.

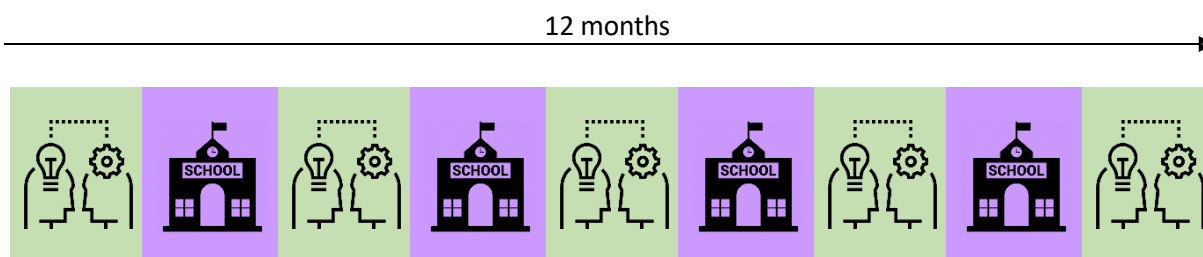




What's involved?

The Julian Teaching School Hub is delighted to be working with the Teacher Development Trust (TDT) and Educate Norfolk on this exciting programme.

The programme runs for 12 months. It consists of five one-to-one coaching sessions with an experienced system leader, interspersed with the whole cohort of headteachers attending day visits to local settings.



Day visits will help headteachers to understand school leadership in different contexts, and form supportive peer networks. They represent a progression from Educate Norfolk's Headteacher Support Programme, rather than duplicating this existing support for new headteachers.
